This application will be kept on file at the Pilot Hill, Inc office, and your personal information will be treated as confidential. Applications will be reviewed by the Pilot Hill Inc. Board nominating committee and presented to the full Board for consideration. All nominees will be contacted and invited to attend an interview meeting or notified that their nomination has not been moved forward for the current term. All new directors are elected by a majority vote of current board members.

Pilot Hill Inc. Purpose:

Pilot Hill, Inc. is organized specifically for the purpose of managing and developing the Pilot Hill Recreation & Wildlife Habitat Management Area east of the city of Laramie . The area includes lands owned by the University of Wyoming, Wyoming Office of State Trust Lands and the Wyoming Bureau of Land Management. The management of this land is governed by leases and legal agreements that dictate the following purposes:

- Protect the Casper Aquifer and wildlife habitat on Pilot Hill.
- Enhance non-motorized recreational opportunities.
- Support economic vitality in Albany County, WY.
- Any other directly related management purposes the Board deems important.

All the above described purposes are to be given equal consideration in making decisions regarding management, activity or use of the Pilot Hill parcels.

Board Member Primary Responsibilities:

1. Serve a minimum of one (1) three-year term* on the Board. Eligible to serve three (3) three-year terms if re-elected. **Length of term may vary.*
2. Participate in the regular and annual meetings and make a serious commitment to actively participate in Pilot Hill committee work, public meetings and events. The Pilot Hill Inc. Board is currently a working board where Directors actively chair and/or participate on committees. This work includes an average of 3-6 hours monthly.
3. Build a collegial working relationship with other Board, committee members and agency partner representatives. Maintain and grow regional support for Pilot Hill.
4. Make an annual contribution at a level that is meaningful to the Director or the Director's appointing or nominating organization.
